



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN TBILISI HUMANITARIAN UNIVERSITY AND MYKOLAS ROMERIS UNIVERSITY No. 2A-29

Tbilisi Humanitarian Teaching University in Georgia, represented by Rector Valentina Sakvarelidze and Mykolas Romeris University in Lithuania, represented by Rector Prof. Dr. Inga Žalėnienė (hereinafter referred to as 'the two parties') hereby agree to establish a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in academic cooperation and exchange between the two universities for the purpose of promoting international development in the following areas:

- (a) Mobility of students for exchange.
- (b) Mobility of faculty members for academic visits and exchange.
- (c) Summer programs/internship programs.
- (d) Joint research supervision of PhD and Master evele students.
- (e) Exchange of scientific materials, publications, and information,
- (f) Research collaboration for faculty and students.
- (g) Joint international research conference and meetings for research.
- (h) Development and promotion of other academic cooperation as mutually agreed.
- 2. The development and implementation of each activity based upon this MoU shall be negotiated and agreed upon by both parties under a separate agreement prior to the initiation of the particular program. All programs and activities under this MoU will be operated in accordance with the laws and regulations of the respective countries.
- 3. All financial arrangements to pursue any of the above activities are to be negotiated for each specific case.
- 4. The details of and arrangements for any publication of research results produced through collaboration under this MoU must be decided and agreed upon in advance in writing by the two parties.

- 5. The two parties agree that in the event of research collaboration leading to patent rights, copyrights, or other intellectual property rights, a further agreement must be negotiated in each case in accordance with the policies of the two parties on intellectual property.
- 6. Amendment of this MoU is to be effected upon deliberation by the two parties. No amendment, consent or waiver of terms of this MoU shall bind either party unless in writing and signed by both parties.
- 7. This MoU shall be effective upon signature by the two parties and shall remain in force for a period of five years. Thereafter it may be reviewed and extended upon agreement by the two parties.
- 8. Termination of this MoU may be effected upon deliberation by the two parties. Either party has the right to terminate the memorandum without liability by giving six months' notice in writing of such intent.
- 9. This MoU is concluded in two copies in English, one copy to each Party.
