The memorandum of understanding is entered into by and between the Warsaw University of Technology and the Tbilisi Humanitarian Teaching University in order to establish effective and mutually beneficial cooperation and develop academic and cultural exchange in education and research areas and promote internationalization of higher education.

The areas of cooperation will include any programs offered at the two universities that will promote the above-mentioned goals. However, any specific program shall be a subject to mutual consent, availability of funds and the consent of both universities. Such programs may include:

- Exchange of students;
- Exchange of faculty staff;
- Exchange of publications;
- Joint research projects and conferences.

The terms of such mutual assistance and cooperation shall be discussed and agreed upon in written form by the responsible authorities of each university, prior to the initiation of any particular program or activity. In case of students' exchange, special learning agreements will be signed, individually for each student.

This agreement shall take effect upon approval by both parties and will remain in force for an initial period of three (3) years. Thereafter, it will be automatically extended for the next period. However, both party may terminate the agreement in writing at least ten months prior to the beginning of an academic term/year.
